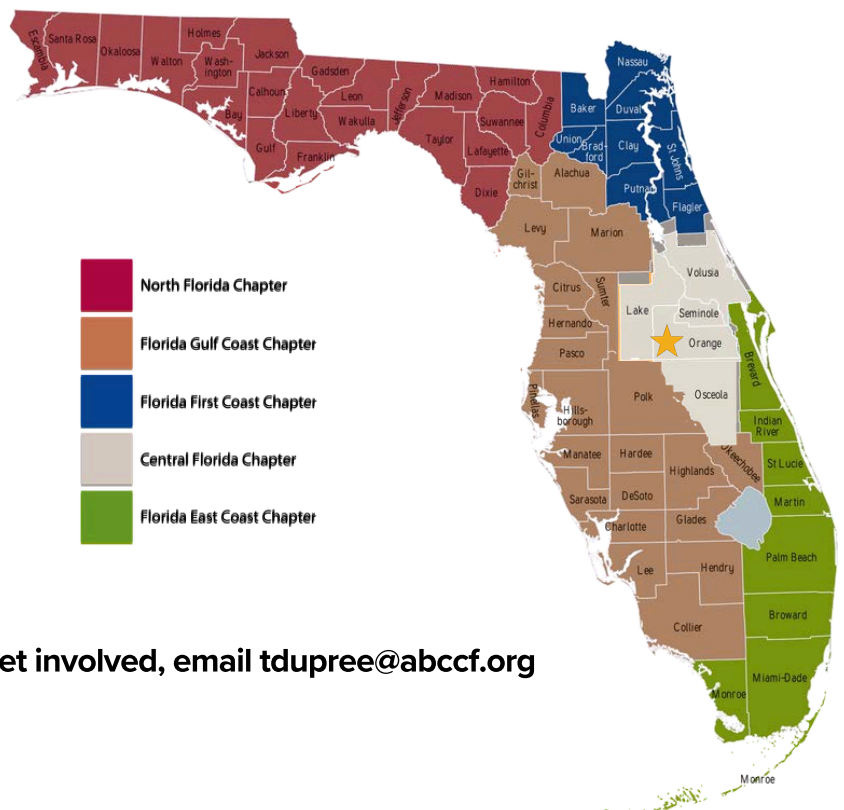

ABC CF has a state and local PAC to represent members' voices. In 2024 and 2025, we contributed over \$2.4 million to elect candidates to the Florida House of Representatives, the Florida Senate, local city, county, and school boards.

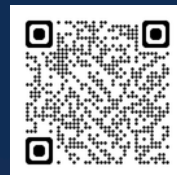

# WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT SEMINARS & CRAFT TRAINING

- ▶ **Fundamentals of Crew Leadership** Leadership involves motivation, coaching, and exemplifying the leadership role. In this 10-week course, attendees will learn from industry professionals and seasoned superintendents to learn what it takes to be a successful leader.
- ▶ **Project Management Institute** **ABC Project Management Institute is a premier education and professional development opportunity for future project management leaders.**  
The ABC Project Management Institute offers premier education for aspiring project management leaders, developed by experienced contractors and expert Kirk Alter. This fast-paced course covers project management essentials through real examples and case studies, equipping participants with valuable tools and skills to succeed and make a positive impact in their organizations.
- ▶ **Safety Academy** This 2-day course is designed to help ABC members on their journeys towards world-class safety and health programs. The Safety Academy is an immersion into developing leadership commitment to safety as a core value from the C-Suite down, establishing a safety culture where safety is not a priority, but a core value, and implementing the leading indicator systems and processes that are required to achieve world-class safety performance.
- ▶ **Stepping Up to Supervisor** This 12-hour course will show participants how their attitude affects others & overall productivity, how to carry out basic day-to-day responsibilities, how to manage yesterday's peers, how to deal with problems, how to get results through other people and how to deal with special situations.

**Hands-on and specific to construction!**

▶ **Hurricane Preparedness**

Hurricanes can cause severe damage to construction sites, especially with the increasing strength and frequency seen in recent years. Proper planning is essential to protect these sites and reduce storm-related risks. The hurricane season begins on June 1 and runs until November 30. Additionally, afternoon storms in Florida are increasing in volatility, highlighting the importance of preparedness. Participants will learn action plans and checklists to stay ready.

▶ **Reasonable Suspicion**

This class helps members address drug use prevention on worksites amidst changing drug laws, the opioid crisis, and mental health challenges. Employers will learn the legal framework, including Florida's Drug-Free Workplace Act, the ADA, and DOT regulations. They will gain confidence in identifying reasonable suspicion and engaging in the interactive process for workplace accommodations.

▶ **Medical Gas Installer 6010 (32 Hour)**

Medical Gas Certification is a requirement in Florida and in most of the United States. Plumbing companies in Florida that install, and repair, these life safety systems and equipment must be certified by an approved training agency that is certified by the Florida Construction Industry Licensing Board.

## CERTIFICATION OFFERINGS

▶ **CPR/First Aid/AED**

This course will teach participants how to recognize a life threatening emergency and how to provide basic life support, including how to recognize the signs and symptoms of injuries and sudden illness, airway obstructions, shock, burns, strains, strokes and seizures.

▶ **OSHA 10**

Workers who successfully complete our OSHA-authorized course will earn their official OSHA 10 card from the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL). Our course is intended as an orientation to OSHA safety training standards. It covers safety and health hazards workers may face on construction work sites, placing special emphasis on hazard identification, avoidance, control and prevention.

▶ **OSHA 30**

The OSHA 30-Hour Construction training educates construction workers and supervisors on OSHA safety standards. Upon completion, participants receive an official OSHA card from the U.S. Department of Labor. This comprehensive course covers hazard identification, avoidance, control, and prevention to ensure job site safety

▶ **Suicide Prevention & Awareness**

Participants will gain the skills and tools needed to appreciate the critical need for suicide prevention while creating a forum for dialogue and critical thinking about workplace mental health challenges, and by promoting help-seeking and help-giving.

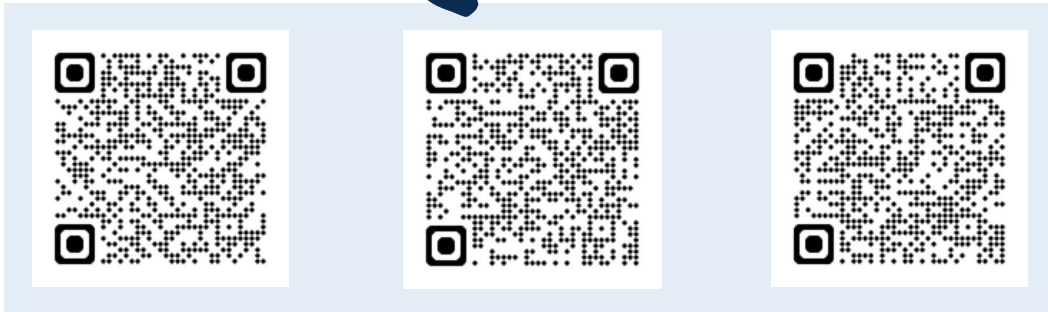
