- TORRES gave an Excellence in Construction Awards Committee update.
 - Working on intent to competes to get an idea of who all is submitted and to get sub lists to reach out to subcontractors about participating or joining as a member and then submitting.

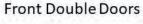

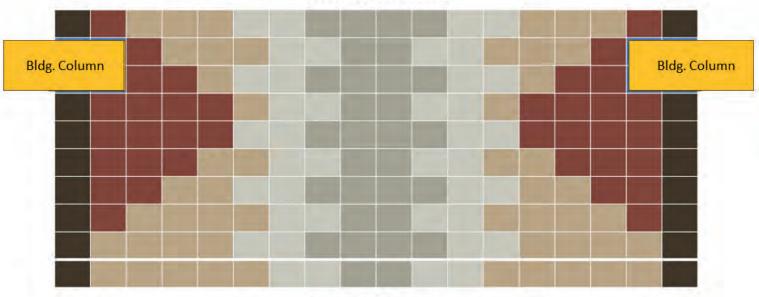

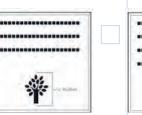
