The Facts

- Child abuse is the leading cause of death in children under the age of 4.
- Violence is a self-perpetuating cycle.
 Without help, victims can be caught in a generational cycle of abuse.
- Abused children suffer from confusion and despair. Without help they may face mental health disorders, juvenile delinquency or substance abuse.
- Each year Kids House serves approximately 2,000 children.
- More than 3 million reports of child maltreatment are received annually in the U.S.
- A report of child abuse is made every 10 seconds in the U.S.
- More than FOUR children die every day in the U.S. as a result of child abuse.
- Child abuse occurs at every socioeconomic level, across ethnic and cultural lines, within all religions and at all levels of education.

Kids House fosters a collaborative, childfocused environment designed to reduce additional trauma to the child, siblings and family, with an emphasis on healing.



Our CPT team members are skilled professionals who conduct non-leading interviews in a child-friendly environment.



In partnership with AdventHealth, our medical team provides forensic medical exams along with follow up care for our child victims.



Each case is assigned a Child Advocate on-site to provide support and resources, while walking the family through the potentially complex process.



Our Licensed Mental Health team provides trauma therapy to our child victims in order to continue the healing process.
